City Council Proclamation

WHEREAS parks and recreation programs are an integral part of communities throughout this country, including Kyle, Texas; and

WHEREAS our parks and recreation are vitally important to establishing and maintaining the quality of life in our communities, ensuring the health of all citizens, and contributing to the well-being of a community and region; and

WHEREAS parks and recreation areas are fundamental to the environmental well-being of our community, and ensure the ecological beauty of our community; and

WHEREAS parks and natural recreation areas improve the quality of the air we breathe; and provide a place for children and adults to connect with nature and recreate outdoors; and

WHEREAS parks and recreation programs build healthy, active communities that aid in the prevention of chronic disease, and also improve the mental and emotional health of all citizens; and

WHEREAS the Kyle Parks and Recreation Department maintains 542 acres of dedicated parkland, coordinates and implements 32 special events a year, and programs youth and adult programs, athletics, aquatic programs, and outdoor exploration; and

WHEREAS the U.S. House of Representatives has designated July as Parks and Recreation Month; and

WHEREAS Kyle, Texas recognizes the benefits derived from parks and recreation resources.
